SOMETHING TO CONSIDER: Not long ago, I heard about a group of people in coastal Massachusetts who mustered forces to help save some sea turtles. Typically the turtles swim north when the waters are warm and, like many human snow birds, go south for the winter. Last year, the waters off New England stayed warm longer than they usually do. The turtles were content to be up north. But, when the waters got cold, to the surprise of the turtles, temperatures dropped so quickly that many got caught and froze. Some washed ashore in sad but treatable shape. Volunteers picked up the near frozen turtles (approx. 150) and took them to a shelter where they were gradually warmed. The volunteers kept them in large tanks for 6 - 8 months and released them to the next year's migration.

This was a nice thing they did. They felt good about it. I think they believe they were doing the Lord's work. Good for them. Would that this were a metaphor for how our society is now looking at babies in danger, i.e., babies in the womb.


