



It's time for men to take a stand, says Knight and president of 40 Days for Life.

Shawn Carney, a member of the Knights of Columbus, has dedicated his life to "removing abortion from the abstract." As president of 40 Days for Life, his appeal to promote pro-life causes has reached an international audience. It even helped convert former Planned Parenthood administrator Abby Johnson.

Recent political and media attention on the abortion issue has raised the stakes of Carney's efforts. But he's not giving up because, as Supreme Knight Carl Anderson recently noted, abortion remains the leading cause of death in America.

"We are culpable," Carney said. "We Catholics live in a nation that has dehumanized an entire group of people so that we can discard them." READ MORE
