He first contacted the Island Turtle Watch. They were unable to do much at the time as they had no volunteers in the area. He was instructed to save them himself. He got them out and carried them to the water. WOW! What a great story. Isn't it great that we have so many concerned people watching out for new-born sea turtles. Would that we had public resources as keenly focused on saving babies...

Our year end donations for the fiscal 2022-2023 were 7,175 pounds of food, \$2,808 in cash, \$65 in gift cards, and 107-man hours. Excellent job gentlemen!

Thanks to your efforts it was a stellar year. The Food for Families forms required by Supreme have been filed and we will receive a \$500 refund from them.

Our year-to-date tally of donations for this fiscal year 2023-2024 are \$1,126 and 6 man hours. I do not know the poundage of food yet because I will not get that information from the SYC pantry until the end of July.
