### **Grand Knights Message**



The 4th ANNUAL UNDEFEATED COURAGE BOULDLESS LOVE GALA is set for December 6 (a Wednesday) at the Stone Gables Estate, STAR BARN in Elizabethtown, PA. Featured speakers are Dr. Anthony and Cecelia Levatino. Dr. Levatino, an abortionist in his early medical career, is now a champion for life. He and his wife will share their stories. (You can pull up videos on the Internet that Dr. Levatino has made. Well worth the effort.)

This event is UNDEFEATED COURAGE's major fundraiser of the year. It is a wonderful affair both for its content and its venue. The decorated estate of Stone Gables at Christmas time is gorgeous

Tickets (tables) will be available starting Sep. 18. Think about attending. Seek out someone who attended in years past.

Brothers, in the summer edition of the MORNINGSTAR (Pregnancy Outreach Center) Newsletter, they extend high praise to the Knights for their three new, 4D Ultrasound devices the Knights purchased. MORNINGSTAR reports that in 2022 they provided 1,329 Ultrasounds. Result: Of the 759 women who were considering abortion, 609 chose Life for their babies. 8891 was a contributor to the effort.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE will start on Sep 27 and run through Nov 5. We have not formally joined the campaign this year but we will still have people praying across the street from Planned Parenthood/York, as we do all year long. We know that on abortion days, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday we will have vigilers on site from approx 7.30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Come join us if the spirit moves you. No need to sign up for a specific vigil hour. And, know this. You will not be there alone.

Brothers, Adam J. MacLeod wrote "C.S. Lewis' MEDITATION IN A TOOLSHED ON THE SACREDNESS OF LIFE", a powerful essay that discusses the eugenics movement. In it he looks at Buck vs. Bell, a legal challenge to the forced sterilization of a young woman named Carrie Buck. In upholding the program, he (Oliver Wendell Holmes, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court) wrote:

"It is better for all the world, if instead of waiting to execute degenerate offspring for crime, or to let them starve for their imbecility, society can prevent those who are manifestly unfit from continuing their kind." He wrote further, "Three generations of imbeciles are enough"


